Dear parents, guardians and carers,

School Reports:

VSWare reports are now live. It is essential to understand that Junior Cycle examinations are not graded the way those over the age of 18 would have experienced. You will not find traditional grades. A mark has been included where this is relevant and helpful. What you will find is that our First Year reports attempt to underline what has gone well and to give advice on how to proceed. As students proceed to Second Year and into Third Year and as students become familiar with the system, we will provide specific test results in all subjects.

You will note that we have provided information on 'what went well' and 'even better if'. We absolutely make no apology for valuing academic performance, but we want our reports to be as helpful to students and parents as possible.

Feedback:

We had originally planned on getting Second Year parental feedback on our parent/teacher meetings. However, we have decided to combine this research with a survey on the assessments, and to include First Year families after their parent/teacher meetings.

Parent Staff Association:

It has been brilliant to see this vital association thrive. There is now a report from a member of the PSA to each board meeting. In terms of communications around schoolwide issues please note the following:

Student Council:

This has become a very popular activity in our school. We are unbeaten as we go into the new year. We have a very articulate group of young people in Goatstown ETSS. Big thanks to Niamh, Anna, Ronan and Patrick for training the teams.

HEPA filters:

The school has received a minor works grant for ventilation which we will use to purchase HEPA filters for each classroom. We have tested one model over the last few weeks which is expensive, but which is suitable for a classroom with up to 30 individuals. There is a delay with suppliers at the moment, but we will do everything possible to have these in place for the new year.

Online Learning:

Nobody wants school to have to go to online learning. And our expectation is to open as normal on January 6th. However, it would be remiss of us to not prepare for the worst. You will find our online protocols and timetables for each class with this app notification. In the event that we have to return to online learning, it is essential to review this document which explains everything you need to know about how we will operate.

First Year 2022:

The Board has decided to limit the number of places to 72 (three First Year Classes) as per our admissions notice. We have almost completed round two of the offers process. There is still a considerable waiting list.

Creativity Week:

Although there is a little while to go, I thought I would share the plan for Creativity Week in February. Thanks to Niall for organising this. Thanks also to Sharon Carty, our Arts Council Associate who has worked with us since we opened.
