Dear parents, guardians and carers,

I hope that this communication finds you well. As the start of the school year approaches, I am contacting you regarding arrangements for Second Year 2021 and with staff updates and other news.

Enrolment:

There are 24 students in Second Year and 48 students in First Year. This means that we are full for 2021-2022. Enrolment for First Year 2022 will open in October. If you know of families interested in their child/ren enrolling in First Year 2022 then please advise them to follow us on Facebook or Twitter or to keep an eye out on the website during October.

Staff:

A very warm welcome to Clodagh Keher, who is our new school administrator and to Suzin Staunton who is our special class teacher. Welcome also to ASN assistants Jane Eccles and Laura Reid. Thank you to Róisín for her support in the office during the first year of the school. We are delighted also to be playing our part in supporting teachers at the start of their careers and welcome four Professional Master's in Education (PME) teachers who will work alongside our experienced staff. The PMEs are: Patrick King: *Science*, Eddie McGinn: *Spanish and CSPE*, Ronan Reddy: *English and Geography*, Deirdre Griffin: *Business and CSPE*.

Accommodation:

The prefab buildings won't be ready until September 24th. This is very frustrating for everyone in the school community. However, please be assured that there will not be any interruption to your child's education in the interim period. Covid-19:

All health advice regarding Covid-19 comes from the DE and HSE. The Board of Management does not have autonomy to make decisions about any aspect of the Covid-19 and its effect on school life.

We will advise whether the meetings on September 16th and September 29th can take place in school closer to the time.

Extra-curricular activities:

It will be possible to offer a greater range of sporting and other activities this year. We will contact you with a list of clubs and activities in mid-September.

School Administration Charge:

This school administration charge covers the cost of licences for office 365, 24-hour pupil injury insurance, a school locker, a school journal and some charges for activities done during the year. If you would like to pay by instalments, then please tick the relevant option in Easy Payments Plus.

Families transferring into Second year will be contacted by the school office to arrange for the setup of the School App and Easy Payments Plus. Families who find it difficult to afford the €150 should contact Clodagh in the office in the strictest confidence.

Communications:

A reminder that all general communications from the school will come via the school app. Please make sure that you have downloaded the app so that you receive relevant notifications from the school relevant to your child.
