What is Cyberbullying?

"placing a once-off offensive or hurtful public message, image or statement on a social network site or other public forum where that message, image or statement can be viewed and/or repeated by other people will be regarded as bullying behaviour"

ACTIVITY: DEALING WITH CYBERBULLYING

Your 13 year old daughter comes to you and tells you that she is upset and doesn't want to go into school tomorrow. She says that she is being mocked in a group chat, her classmates use it to share jokes and make plans for the weekend.

She has seen that rumours are being spread about her in the chat and that some children have photo shopped her face onto faces of photos of animals and obese adults and they are posting them alongside nasty comments about her appearance.

How do you think you should respond?







How to respond to scenario:

- PRAISE THEM FOR SHARING AND SHARE SCREEN GRABS WITH THE SCHOOL
- LISTEN AND DO NOT JUDGE
- SUPPORT THEM
- DON'T REMOVE TECHNOLOGY.
- BUILD CONFIDENCE.

DEALING WITH CYBERBULLYING

- Don't reply
- Keep the message
- Block the sender
- Talk to someone


ACTIVITY: SOCIAL NETWORKING






- Discord

 - Video-chatting app, allowing users to connect with up to 8 people at a time




Snapchat
